Residents across the route will have begun to receive our road closure information postcards and letters. This information will provide timings and locations of road closures, parking restriction and crossing points. We have also distributed this information to businesses and key partners via our email database.

Road closure advanced warning signs have been installed around the city and Variable Message System (VMS) will begin to display event warning messages from today.
